### Essence of Elevated Versions of 31st December 2010

"It is good that the aim of you spiritual children is the same as that of Father Brahma, of becoming complete and perfect. The determined thought of remaining free from obstacles will bring the time of completion close. You children will fulfil the thought that you have had, and you will serve with your mind those who are unhappy and peaceless in the world; you will give them one support or another because God cannot bear to hear the calling out and crying out in distress of the children. They are all part of your family, are they not? Sorrow and peacelessness are increasing a lot, and so, now, become merciful. Have this thought that while walking and moving around, and at *Amrit Vela*, you will definitely serve souls with your mind. Just as you will finish your old *sanskars* and become equal to God the Father, in the same way, become *master* Bestowers, children of God, the Bestower, and definitely serve souls of the world with your mind. Are you ready to serve through your mind? Throughout the day, whatever time you have, definitely serve through the mind in that period because it is you children who have to bring about the world of happiness. Souls are crying out, "Give! Give! (Give peace and happiness)", so you have to give happiness to those who are unhappy. Give strength to those who are distressed and do some charitable work.

Therefore, check yourself and write your report and give it to your BK teacher."

# BRAHMA BABA – THE ARCHANGEL OF THE GOLDEN AGE

rahma Baba, the founding father of Brahma Kumaris World Spiritual University, who had initiated, nurtured and brought up thousands of his spiritual progeny into spiritual and yogic culture, gave up his physical sheath on the night of 18th January, 1969 and yet this was not the end of the holy services he had been rendering to the suffering humanity but was, in fact, the opening of a new chapter or widening of the new horizons. Now had begun a new saga of his life, seldom heard of before in the ancient spiritual lore or in the medieval spiritual annals, for, except in reference to Brahma, one does not find the use of the word 'Avyakt' (angelic) in reference to the angelic stage attained by another *sadhu* or saint.

Minutes before the corporeal Brahma Baba breathed his last, he had addressed an assembly of Brahma Kumaris and Brahma Kumars in the Discourse Hall of Pandav Bhawan – also

called Madhuban at Mount Abu. He had led mass meditation there at the end of the discourse and, with a smiling face, had bidden good bye to the gathering. "Alright sweet children, good bye!", he said on that night, instead of saying: 'Good Night', which had been his usual form of ending his address every night for years and, it is strange enough, that though many in the gathering had noticed this change in words, yet no one had really imagined what would happen during the next half-an-hour or so.

Of course, those, who were with him or who had been with him a few days earlier, had noticed a deepseated change in his level of existence. Though there are no appropriate words, yet one could, perhaps, sum up the description of his mental and spiritual stage by saying that he was deeply detached from his body and from the gross world and was in a stage of heightened soul-

consciousness and intense meditation so much so that. as one sat near him, one effortlessly felt detachment from one's body and had a deep feeling of silence, lightness, dispassion and disinterestedness in worldly things and, above all, an ethereal joy. When someone was talking to Baba, it seemed that Baba was listening to him in a strangely different way and yet he was listening; he was here and yet he was not here. He gave attention only to the essence and not the details and was most of the time, withdrawn to his inner self and it seemed as if he felt that his role as a corporeal being had almost ended and he was soon to embark on his journey for the angelic world which lay beyond the azure sky and also beyond the realm of stars. His mind's eye was set in the spiritual summit, so to say, and therefore, as he met the inmates of Pandav Bhawan and talked and also took his food and smiled and did other things seemingly as usual, he was just getting ready to go beyond the starry region. The difference was not very much visible to all but yet was there for a discerning eye to see.

It was a little more perceptible at the level of feeling rather than seeing. One could feel less of his physical presence but more of his luminous silvery presence. As one looked into his eyes, one got transported into a higher level of existence and felt as if not only was one surrounded by its divine light but had also become selfluminous being. One got a pleasant experience of divine joy that was the real charm of life.

And, ever since Brahma Baba became Avyakt, i.e. angelic, one can see an uptrend in the level of consciousness of those who are having the benefit of the teachings of the Brahma Kumaris World Spiritual То University. have awareness of an Angel as their loving and beloved guide is in itself a spiritual achievement. The beneficiaries of the teachings do not consider anyone in gross corporeal form as their guru or guide but they look on the incorporeal Supreme Soul Shiva as their Spiritual Preceptor and, next to Him, they look on Angelic Brahma as their beloved holy father who too gives them spiritual

guidance and help. They have, in him, a role model to follow. Brahma's life-history, which is centred round has transformation into an angel from a human being who once was a layman for them, an aspiring story and a practical instance that strongly motivates them to ascend higher and higher so as to become an angel.

Moreover, the visits of Brahma Baba, the Archangle, give great benefit to the students in many other ways. Not only does Brahma Baba infuse new enthusiasm in their spiritual efforts, but he always gives them great blessings and bestows great love and care. He reveals to them many secrets of what is beyond and tells them many esoteric truths and stratagems of spiritual practice. One feels it a great privilege to meet him when he visits through a corporeal medium and one gets ethereal joy and divine ecstasy when he looks at them and speaks to them in so affectionate, intimate and soul-stirring tones that one feels enchanted with the notes of his divine flute.

Brahma Baba has been, to all his spiritual progeny, a symbol of harmony. One of

his foremost teachings has been that his listeners would become like 'milk and sugar' and would never be like 'salt and water'. He has always been instructing to speak at a low pitch and to utter soft and sweet words. He has very clearly asked everyone never to hurt anyone even slightly. He has discoursed for inner and outer harmony, for his aim is to establish a world of harmony where even the beasts have shed off their enmity and violence and where no one has any fear of anyone else. On the occasion of 42nd Ascension Day of Father of Humanity -Prajapita Brahma, let us pledge that we will follow him in thought, word and deed and, being the progeny of this Adi Dev – the bestower of fortune- we too would become master bestowers of fortune.

Provided here-below are such Divine Versions for the benefit of our esteemed readers. Though these versions have been addressed to the BKs who follow the spiritual principles in their practical life, yet these are very much relevant to all spiritual seekers and we hope our esteemed readers would take maximum benefit from these versions which are very much on the special theme of this issue on Purity in Thought, Word and Deed. – Editor]

urity does not just mean celibacy. Complete purity means that none of the vices should be touched even in thought. Just as in life, Brahmins consider any physical attraction or physical touching to be impure, in the same way, if the mind or the intellect is attracted to or touched by the thought of any vices that is also considered to be an impurity. Those who have the personality of purity, the royalty of purity will not touch that which is unclean. even through their mind or intellect.

The personality of purity means greatness and speciality in every action. Personality means to remain constantly busy in serving the self and others, that is, not to waste your energy, time and thoughts, but to use them in a worthwhile way (Avyakt, 4.12.1991).

Accurate faith is: I now belong to the Father, the Supreme Soul, and I recognise, accept and move along considering myself to be a soul, and know the Father as He is. This is accurate faith. If you have number one faith, then as you progress, you should not find it difficult to imbibe the main subject of purity. If purity makes you fluctuate even in your dreams, then understand that your foundation of the Number One faith is weak. This is because the original religion of the soul is purity. Impurity is an external influence and purity is your original religion. So when you have the faith of your original religion, no other religion can make you fluctuate (Avyakt, 4.12.1995).

The foundation is purity. However, the definition is very deep. Where there is purity, all the things that you all spoke about - having a faithful intellect, honesty and cleanliness etc. - all these things are included in that. However, BapDada sees that the deep definition or significance of purity is not very clear in your intellect. To have waste thoughts or to enable waste thoughts to be created, to have waste thoughts yourself or to be an instrument to create waste thoughts in others; is it purity to have these waste thoughts? Are waste thoughts purity? So all of you should put the significance of purity in thoughts into practice. If you examine it, out of all the five vices, from lust to attachment - the first vice is lust and the last is attachment – when any vice comes, where does it first come? It first enters your thoughts, does it not? Or, does it come in your actions first? It first comes in your thoughts. Would you not call those thoughts, waste thoughts? You would. Anger also creates waste thoughts. Lust means to have wasteful vision. If you have wasteful vision towards any soul, would that be accepted as purity? It would not. So, why do you not surrender your waste thoughts out of love for the Father? Are you able to do this? It is very easy to say, "Haan Ji". However, BapDada has everyone's chart. Even now, the majority of you have thoughts based on the five vices. "Why is it like this? Why is it like that? It should be like this." And, something common that BapDada tells you about is that knowledgeable souls either have arrogance of their virtues or their specialities, and the more they progress, the more their weakness in a particular aspect is seen. It is not a weakness in terms of making effort, but a weakness in terms of wanting name and fame, regard, in being made a centre-in-charge, in being given a special part in service: the waste thoughts of this weakness cause a lot of damage especially in knowledgeable souls. And, nowadays, these two are the main basis of waste thoughts. Just look at your timetable for one day. At present, you are sitting in Madhuban, and nothing as such happens in Madhuban. However, when you return to your service place, check yourself. In one day, check these two aspects: Arrogance and the feeling of being insulted. "Why did I receive so little? I should also have this status. I should also be forward." You do understand this to be arrogance also, do you not? The reason for waste thoughts nowadays are the two aspects of arrogance and of feeling insulted. If you surrender these two, then it is not difficult to become like the Father. So, do you have the power to surrender them? Achchha (Avyakt 7.11.1995)

### MERCY

Mercy is the quality that sees behind expression to the need that is inside it. Blend the anger to the sadness,, behind the coldness to the fear. Mercy goes behind and meets the hidden needs of a person's mind, their child-self.

To have mercy is to know the vulnerability that is in you and feed it with what you are learning, so that it strengthens and becomes level with your adulthood and calmness. Mercy is to know that, though it often asks for what is visible and material, the mind's needs are deeper and more demanding and cannot be met by anything false or short-term.

Mercy is the wisdom to see that a failing mind needs a system in which to meet its needs. Real mercy is not, therefore, merely softness or compassion, but a spiritual system whose clear footsteps hold God's presence and so followed, become a meeting point with Him. That meeting is itself the most valuable present a human mind can receive. In it lies a training for the senses; a training to draw them inwards. So alone from influence, the mind can regain its strength and learn what is unique to it – as though, in a moment of quiet victory, it receives its own inheritance.

When a mind finds its strength again, it develops the confidence to re-enter the world and be alive and gifted in it. Mercy is to keep the strictness until the last moment and to help others do the same, so that they no longer bank their lives on temporary attractions, but move towards the hidden beauty that is in them.

This is why it is wrong to blame someone when they hurt you, for blame sees only what is outside and not what lies behind it. Mercy is to think, do and speak only what leads inwards to where the real reasons lie.

ncorporeal God Shiva, the benefactor and purifier of all souls, disseminates through the corporeal medium of Prajapita Brahma several spiritual truths. Those truths might have been available to devotees on the path of bhakti or worship but they could not take full benefit of those due to lack of precision and clarity. One of such truths is the existence of the entity called soul. It has been revealed by the Supreme Father that soul has three faculties which are manifested in our day-to-day routine and these motivate all activities in human life.

The first faculty called Mind is the thinking faculty of the soul. It is mind which generates thoughts, desires, ambitions etc. Intellect is the second faculty that differentiates, discriminates, determines and decides as to which thoughts have to be implemented or not. These actions performed by soul are stored in the form of *Sanskaras* or resolves.

It is truly said of mind: Manah ev manushyanam karnam bandh mokshyoh

It means mind is the cause of bondage as well as liberation in life (fruition). Purity of mind is a real gift of God. When we are in body-consciousness, we can't feel inner happiness, peace and bliss. Soul always finds itself in bondage, there are 'how', 'why' and 'when' at each and every step. Extrovert nature results into slavery of the sense organs, as uncontrolled mind leads to exasperation and depression. The wings of zeal and enthusiasm are cut. There is fear of death and various mental and physical disorders. The power of discrimination is depleted and there is lack of concentration. Enveloped by confusion and chaos, the soul fails to take any inspiration from the past and there appears no hope in the near future. Attracted to bodies and physical pleasures, the soul becomes a slave to name and fame. Peeved and grilled by sense organs, the soul revels in the game of criticizing and blaming others. It picks up only flaws in the other actors of this World Drama. Life of such a soul seems to be revolving around 'I' and 'My'. Egotism and self interest make the soul slave of the artificial pomp and show due to vagaries of mind. Soul loses the power to discriminate between right and wrong. Unable to analyse human beings as well as situations, one is driven away from real well-wishers and is surrounded by flatterers and selfish persons.

#### A Mind That Is Kind

Those who think positive are always conscious of their original self-pure, peaceful, blissful and benevolent. They deal only in positive aspects of personality. Being stabilized in their original state of piety, they have regard for the fellow beings, are polite and free from arrogance. Like a swan they pick up only specialty and goodness in others. As they remain soul-conscious, all their virtues start spreading in social circles. They feel the presence of light, might and divine insight, as they are free from the waste and the bondage of sorts. They take all responsibility for their actions as they are able to control the self and also inspire others to positivity, creativity, cooperation and cohesion. Their zeal and enthusiasm in various life situations act as a beacon to other souls to perform better.

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Not engrossed in sense organs and the physical objects, they stay stabilized, steadfast and concentrated. They perform all actions with detachment, considering themselves trustees. These characteristics enable one to become an embodiment of all divine virtues and spiritual powers. Brahma Baba was the greatest example of such purity in thoughts, words and deeds.

#### TRANSCENDING TIME AND SPACE

Brahma Baba had put special and concerted endeavours to have such an exalted state of mind. He used to get up early in the morning and send vibrations of peace, spiritual succour and relief to souls; as a result of it, many souls would have divine visions and got inspiration to tread the path of righteousness and Rajyoga. This gets corroborated by the following anecdote.

A young boy in San Francisco was studying in a college. He got introduction of BKs philosophy and was really inspired by it. After completing the introductory course of Rajyoga Mediation, one day he took his mother to the BK centre .When his mother entered the meditation room, she got extremely surprised on

seeing the trans-light picture of Brahma Baba. When enquired, she disclosed an incident that occurred when he was just born. "My dear child", she said "When you were born, I had a divine vision wherein I saw an elderly person in white robes and an angel-like appearance. He asked me to give the new born child to him, for welfare of the world. I got perplexed and confused for fear of separation from you. The vision soon disappeared and with the passage of time I forgot all about it". Till then, the mother had not told about the vision to anyone. The son was really inspired to realize that God required his services for transformation of the vicious world into a veritable heaven. This personal experience was narrated to me by the B.K brother from San Francisco during our first visit to BKs international headquarters at Mount Abu in July 1979.

#### WORDS OF BLESSINGS

Even in his personal and professional life before surrendering himself to Almighty God Shiva, Brahma Baba always practised purity of words. He spoke only such words which were soothing and inspiring. His words became divinised as he treaded further on this spiritual path. The versions uttered through his lotus-mouth became blessings for the entire humanity.

Brahma Baba was well aware of the gigantic responsibility the Supreme Soul had entrusted to him by making him the human medium to reveal universal truths about soul, matter, nature and God. Brahma Baba always kept attention and he encouraged others on the path of righteousness.

But at the same time, these six small and simple words are as easy to understand at the level of theory, as they are difficult to follow at the level of practice, for the simple reason that practising and living pure thoughts, pure words and pure deeds require a complete metamorphosis, i.e., complete change of character on the part of man.

What comes home is that all our thoughts, words and deeds generate from the character we inculcate and build in ourselves. Character building, therefore, is the keynote of the subject under study.

Our thoughts and words are governed by what and how we see, listen, read, touch, smell and feel and our deeds are a by-product of how our mind commands our intellect and body to react to what we have seen, heard, read, touched, smelt and felt. In the Murli classes, Baba repeatedly keeps telling us, the spiritual children, to make and keep our eyes civil and not to let them become criminal because eyes (being a very important sense organ) determine the level of our purity or otherwise. In this context, the role of ears is also of great significance. That listening is a tough and ennobling human activity, gets substantiated and authenticated by the fact that Shri Guru Nanak Dev Ji, in 'Jap Ji Sahib' has composed four 'Pauris' (steps number *eight to eleven) on the subject* of listening and on the significance of listening to 'Gyan', i.e., Divine Knowledge. In Pauri No.Ten, Guru Nanak Dev Ji has, in simple and unequivocal terms, blessed mankind with the words that listening to 'Gyan' helps us get into Sahaj Dhyan, i.e., the intellect gets connected to Divine

Knowledge with total ease and poise. In the last line of Tenth Pauri, Guru Nanak Dev Ji refers to the activity of listening to Gyan as a destroyer of all human sufferings and of all human vices.

The purification ofthoughts stems from judicious, gentle and noble use of all our sense organs. But it needs to be stressed again, that this triple purity can be attained only by practising what our spiritual masters have preached. Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi, whom we worship as an apostle of Truth and Non-Violence equates attainment of triple purity to reducing oneself to Zero. In spite of having lived all his life on the principles of triple purity, he says, "I know that I have still before me a difficult path to traverse. I must reduce myself to Zero".

Mahatma Gandhi closes his autobiography, 'My Experiments with Truth' with the following heart-touching appeal to his readers: -"Ahimsa is the farthest limit of humility. In bidding farewell to the reader, for the time being at any rate, I ask him to join with me in prayer to the God of Truth that He

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may grant me the boon of Ahimsa in mind, word and deed".

In all my humility and as my personal homage to Mahatma Gandhi, I will love to put on record that so hypnotizing and mesmerizing is Gandhiji's message of purity that during all the five months when I was writing my book ' Gandhian Thoughts; even the remotest thought of any type of vice was not entertained by the mind. So much so that my better half used to ask me -Are you writing on Gandhi or becoming a Gandhi?

The closing words of the great Mahatma's autobiography are a testimony of his abiding commitment to the principle of remaining as harsh as truth while judging himself. These words are also a testimony of the reality that attaining triple purity is no child's play. Satyam Shivam Sundaram (God is Truth and Beauty) and Satyamev Jayate (Truth; and truth alone triumphs) are the axis around which universal spiritual philosophy revolves. Such is the beauty and power of truth that it transfers all its glory to whatever it looks at or touches. In fact, truth is the only sublime force that brings

transformation without use of force. We, the chosen few children of Shiv Baba are fortunate that, through the human medium of Brahma Baba, the way of attaining triple purity has been disclosed and revealed to us in the easiest and simplest human terminology.

#### **Baba's benevolence**

All the spiritual aspirants experience Brahma Baba's subtle vibrations of help and succour. The verse below which Baba guided me to title as BABA – THE WORLD TRANSFORMER is my personal experience of the touch of Spirituality that flows and shall always continue to flow, from the friend, philosopher and guide of his children.

### DRAWING OUT POWER FROM POWERHOUSE

lmost everyday in Murli (God's version), Shiv Baba reminds us to get-up at Amritvela, the most auspicious time and empower ourselves through the power of deep meditation, i.e., remembrance of Him. During that hour. He offers unlimited treasures. Those, who win over the sleep, become the winner of the treasures. These treasures are not material in nature, but are subtle and these strengthen the soul spiritually. The more one remains in this awareness, the better will be his communication with God which enables him to draw out the power from Him.

# Effective ways of drawing power

1.Body-consciousness is the root-cause of all vices. It is this which causes disturbance in meditation. Therefore, one should be aware of this and remain soul-conscious. Unless the rubber insulation is removed from the electric wire, neither the two poles (ends) can be joined together nor will electricity (power) flow in between. Thereby neither the powerhouse can send the power nor can the receiver acquire it. So, one's prime aim must be to remove bodyconsciousness.

- 2. The greater the attraction towards Supreme Soul, the stronger will be the shower of power from Him. Hence, one must love Him from the core of his heart.
- 3. Waste thoughts should not be allowed to root in deeply at any cost, for they will cause obstruction in meditation.
- 4.See no evil, hear no evil, think no evil and do no evil, lest that may peep into meditation and break concentration.
- 5.Since all the souls of the world are progeny of one Supreme Soul, one must see them as his or her brother soul. When one sees others with this vision, one always thinks of their welfare, irrespective of their caste, creed and country. This evokes the attitude of mutual love and entitles us to have the blessings of BABA.
- 6.Besides, one must help each soul for spiritual elevation as per one's need.
- 7.One must have peace inside and outside home so that there

will be atmosphere of peace and tranquillity all-around, which will remove all the disturbances during meditation.

- 8.One must always remember God's advice to neither give sorrow to anyone nor accept it, which will help the spiritual aspirant to have direct connection with the powerhouse, i.e. Supreme Soul.
- 9.Once a spiritual aspirant has direct connection with Supreme Soul, then, obviously he puts in his body, mind and wealth in Baba's services. This also ensures removal of waste thoughts.
- 10.Moreover, one should keep the mind fresh, alert and cheerful and have a sound sleep.

- 8. Through the powerful remembrance of Baba, one will do worldly jobs, thinking the self as an instrument of Baba.

One's outlook will be widened and ideas brightened in Baba's services. Drawing out spiritual power from the Supreme Soul is our God Fatherly birthright. The more, the merrier. ■

### MAKING THE CONNECTION

What is the practice needed to reach the Supreme? What enables us to experience the connection in a steady and reliable way? Meditation. Meditation means staying in the consciousness of being a soul, a divine, thinking and feeling spirit, and experiencing 'Om Shanti' – being a peaceful soul and making that experience your reality. 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#### SETTLING THE KARMIC ACCOUNT

The soul performs sins birth after birth during *Dwapar yuga* (Copper Age) and Kaliyuga (Iron Age) under the influence of vices. These sins get accumulated, if not settled in the same birth, and then are carried forward to next births.

#### VARIOUS METHODS TO SETTLE KARMIC ACCOUNTS:

#### **Through suffering:**

▶ 1) The pending sins of the past lives to be settled by either mental distress (Bhogna) or Yoga (remembrance of God).

In other words, one can settle these karmic accounts either through igniting the fire of remembrance in Seed Stage and burning the sins and becoming *Karmaateet* or through sufferings in various ways:

✤ Natural Calamities: This is a quick method of settlement of all sins performed and accumulated during *Dwapar Yuga* and *Kaliyuga*. Since it is now final period and everyone has to return home, the bulk settlement takes place by suffering the pains and sorrow of untimely deaths and quick births [jail of womb]. Every pregnancy is like a prison term for the soul, in foetus. The soul, trapped in the mother's womb, suffers and settles a part of karmic account. He is given a vision of the vikarma he had committed and only then he is punished by the Dharmaraj. He that he will assures improve and requests to take him out. Finally, the child comes out crying. In his early childhood, he is really very sweet. However, as the time goes, the University of World teaches him the mundane tricks of the trade.

★ Handicapped or deformed body: This is another common method where soul suffers bodily and mentally; thus it settles the past sins.

Punishment through Dharmaraj: At the end, all our sins appear in front of us like evil spirits; the so-called Demons of Death make us scared. There will be severe pain, much worse than that in the worst jails of today like feeling of peeling of skins etc. and internal burning leading to serious cries of distress and repentance. One second's punishment will be felt as if suffering for months.

▶ 2) The mental disease due to stress, distress, panic and trauma due to the feelings and sentiments of hurt in relationships also result in settling of the account.

▶ 3) The physical sicknesses help us to settle *karmic* account.

♦ 4) Loss of wealth, property, power, status and prestige are also the means of settling the account.

▶ 5) By the Fire of Yoga (*Yoga-agni*):

When we honestly tell the Father, The Sun of Truth, whatever misdeeds we have committed in this present life, 50% of the same is waived of by Him. However, we have to remain alert for not repeating the same misdeeds. The remaining 50% can be absolved by the fire of yoga. Even then it is quite likely that one may get slight suffering like pricking of a thorn instead of crucification. However, the soul may not feel the sorrow as

it is detached and it lets the body settle the account.

However, the pending *karmas* of the past lives have to be settled totally by yoga.

#### TYPES OF KARMA

Based on quality of action, they are classified into three categories: *Sukarma* (good action), *Akarma* (Neutral Action) and *Vikarma* (Bad or vicious action). Let us define these actions for better clarity. ▶ I) Definition based on benevolence of the action: \$1. SUKARMA: These are good actions. Actions that bring benefit to all are known as *sukarma*.

Here, there are two possibilities; 1) The doer of the action and others also get benefitted. 2) Though others are benefitted and happy, the doer suffers.

 performs for his benefit, without causing sorrow or harm to others, e.g., taking shower is for his benefit and it doesn't cause sorrow or harm to others.

♦3. VIKARMA: These are bad or vicious actions. These actions cause sorrow to others for self-interest of the doer.

Here again, there are two distinct possibilities: 1) the doer is benefitted at the cost of others and 2) The doer and others, all suffer by the action of the doer, both the *karmas* are misdeeds; but which one of these is worse?

In today's world, we can understand that for selfish motive, one may cause sorrow to an innocent person. But a terrorist kills many innocent persons including babies and mothers for no reason; he also kills himself, which is beyond understanding. It is a heinous act.

# ▶ II) Definition based on Values and virtues:

*Sukarmas* are the actions performed, based on values and virtues—Peace, Purity, Love, Happiness etc.

*Akarmas* are neither based on virtues, nor on vices. For example eating food is *akarma*, as it doesn't involve virtues or vices.

*Vikarmas* are the actions based on vices – Greed, Ego,

Arrogance etc.

In other words, Purity in action is *Sukarama* whereas impurity in action is *Vikarma*. The entire Drama is based on purity of the person. ▶ III) Definition based on quality of thought –

The seed of the action is thought. Thought is an action of the mind. Every thought creates vibrations, which, in turn, create the atmosphere. Let us classify these actions based on quality of thought. We know that there are mainly four types of thoughts – Positive, Negative, Ordinary and Waste. Waste thoughts are not brought into action, so they are waste. Hence we will consider three types – positive, negative and ordinary only.

Sukarmas or Good Deeds are the actions based on positive thoughts. The speed of these thoughts is very slow. Every positive thought energises us and creates a peaceful and cheerful atmosphere. Actions based on **positive** thoughts bring benefit.

*Akarmas* or Ordinary Deeds are the actions based on ordinary thoughts. These thoughts are based on mundane, day-to-day activities like eating, sleeping etc. They may bring benefit to us, but they do not bring sorrow to others. Actions based on **ordinary thoughts** are neutral actions or *Akarmas*.

*Vikarmas* or Misdeeds are those actions which are based on negative thoughts. The speed of this kind of thoughts is very fast. They may bring benefit to us but at the cost of loss or harm to others.

# ▶ IV) Definition based on the consciousness behind the action:

The intentions behind the actions are very important. The mother slaps a child to draw his attention to his studies; the pain is ignored seeing her pure intention. The doctor operates and removes a part of the body which can cause lot of pain and even make a person handicapped. However, everyone from the family of the patient, including patient himself, gives him profound thanks and pays his bills also. A military sergeant, who kills a few enemies on the border and saves the nation, is honoured and decorated with medal on his chest. So the consciousness with which the action is performed is very important.

When one stabilises the self in soulconsciousness and attunes himself in the love and remembrance of God (God consciousness), it is called yoga. Action is Karma. So action performed in **soul-consciousness** and in **God-consciousness** (remembrance of God) is known as "**Charitable Action**", as the rewards are 100-fold than the ordinary *Sukarma*. This method is known as "**Karma Yoga**" and the soul performing such actions is known as a '*karmayogi*'.

*Akarmas* are the actions performed in **soulconsciousness** but without remembering God.

*Vikarmas* are the actions performed in **body-consciousness**.

### MANAGEMENT LESSONS FROM MURLI

N 26th October 2010, I was listening to Baba's *sakar Murli* at the centre, as usual in the morning. When certain sentences of the Murli were read, I sat up in rapt attention and started wondering how Baba teaches us, His innocent children, in a remarkably easy manner and flowing language, concepts of far-reaching import, evolved by celebrated thinkers and authors of modern management theories.

Incorporeal God Shiva, speaking through the corporeal medium of Prajapita said, "When military personnel go to battlefield, it is their duty to fight enemies. Military is called out. even when there are floods or when some strife occurs. Then military personnel start performing the task of other kind of workers. Government orders them to fill mud etc. If they don't turn up, they face the Orders of the bullet. government must be obeyed". Baba says to them, "You are also bound to do service. should You report

*immediately wherever Baba tells you to go for service. If you do not obey, you cannot be called military.*"

Henri Fayol (1841-1925), one of the early new age management gurus, propounded a set of 14 principles of management, one of which is "discipline". Discipline is defined as "obedience, proper conduct in relation to others, respect of authority, etc." It is essential for the smooth functioning of all organizations. The views and suggestions of employees or members of a team connected with any project or activity can be ascertained and given due consideration before formulating an action plan. But once the plan is finalized and approved by the management, reluctance or resistance to its implementation will only result in chaos. Among all the organizations, military is singularly renowned for discipline. That is why Baba calls us as warriors and our organization as spiritual military.

Baba says - "You are helpers of Baba, in the service of spreading His message to all. Suppose a big museum is opened somewhere 10 miles away; you have to go there for service, don't you have to? Should you think of the cost then? Orders are received from the highest on high Government, the Unlimited Father, whose right hand is Dharamraj'

Cost benefit analysis is an important decision-making tool used by management of organisations. Management parlance also includes similar concepts like return on investment, risk-return tradeoff etc. Baba spells out in simple terms, the cost (efforts put in by us for service), the benefits (kingdom for 21 births) alternatively or the consequences of not investing the cost (falling on the way). Can there be a better or more practical exposition of the concept of cost-benefit analysis?

Baba says – "Once you give the introduction of Baba, then no one will have the courage to ask questions. Once the soul (new student sitting before you) has strong faith in Baba, then explain how souls go through the cycle of 84 births. When the

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soul has understood the world cycle and Baba, then no questions will arise first giving the introduction of Baba ... You have to explain everything in a simple manner and slowly."

Peter Drucker (1909 -2005), acclaimed as the creator and inventor of modern management, said: In communicating, the first question has to be, "Is this communication within the recipient's range ofperception? Can he receive it?" If communication fits in with the aspirations, the values, the purposes of the recipient, it is powerful. If it goes against his aspirations, his values, his motivation, it is likely not to be received at all, or, at best, to be resisted." Management jargon has been nicely simplified for us by Baba, when He tells us to explain spiritual knowledge to fellow brethren in a simple manner, step by step and after watching their response.

Baba further says – "Those who can explain (spiritual knowledge) well should help in service at big museums. You should leave your centres for a few days and go out for service. Prepare someone else to manage your centre (in your

absence). If you do not empower others to manage, then Baba will consider that you are not good enough and you have not done any service. .. Baba's orders to be obeyed ought spontaneously. Such an obedient instrument soul is called 'maharathi', i.e. stalwart (most courageous and high ranking warrior – who rides chariots). Rest all are those who follow on horses and on foot. Everyone has to help in service."

Management theories talk about *delegation*, which is the assignment of authority and responsibility to another person (normally from a *manager to a subordinate)* to carry out specific activities. The person who delegates the work remains accountable for the outcome of the delegated work. Delegation empowers a subordinate to make decisions, i.e. it is a shift of decision-making authority from one organisational level to a lower one. Delegation, if properly done, is not abdication. The opposite of effective is microdelegation management, where a manager provides too much

input, direction and review of delegated work. In general, delegation is good and can save money and time, help in building skills, and motivate people. Poor delegation, on the other might hand. cause frustration and confusion to all the involved parties. Baba is engaged in the unique and major task of world transformation with the vision of all of us as rulers of the new world and hence is preparing us to shoulder higher responsibilities by teaching one more tool of management!

Baba often says that the spiritual knowledge He imparts to us is simple and that He narrates it to us like a story. However, it is important to always remember that each point of knowledge given to us by Baba is a jewel worth lakhs of Rupees. If we start our day by listening to Baba's Murli, preferably in the morning, revise them during the course of the day and churn the points in depth and from different perspectives to capture their sense and essence (as attempted above, by drawing parallels between Baba's words and concepts of modern management), we can achieve clarity and supersensuous joy.

*Tivati* or destiny is very simple and mathematical. But it has been made complex and frightful by scriptures like garuda-purana. Very bad act of a sort invites horrid punishment. It generates Fear-Psychosis in the reader. Life, which is simple and our perception about the Self and the God have been made quite complex. Both are described as "Neti, Neti", i.e., 'this is not that' and 'that is not that'. Then the question is what exactly is that which forms that? People then leave it unexplored as they do not have time even for themselves.

An attempt to interpret self and God from Upanishads (so called simpler versions of *Veda*) lands one in a greater quagmire of confusion. A half page of definition of self, the soul, interpreted so differently in different Vedas that the Self gets lost in the maze of words. Desperate men then seek a Guru. But one soon realises that one cannot get a real Guru in this extreme *Kaliyuga*. All the Gurus, without a single exception, show different manifestations of Maya. Some are famous for their temper. The others are so for their Superego. EGO is erasing God Out. But when one discovers lust-laden episodes of a Guru, then the disenchantment becomes complete. Spiritual effort then becomes rudderless, useless and meaningless. Many leave the path because of this obstacle or difficulty.

One Baba (believer of destiny) preached that everything in life is destiny. When a friend said, "I don't believe in destiny", that Baba replied, "Not to believe in destiny is your destiny." When I asked, "How can I change destiny?" he said, "As per Destiny Yoga, nothing changes destiny." Thus, when I was at the cross-roads of indecision, RAJYOGA happened in my destiny. Then my thoughts, nature and destiny changed easily, surely though slowly. A 7-day free of cost course in

Prajapita Brahma Kumaris Rajyoga Centre at Colaba, Mumbai, gave me my first liberation from superstitions by a very precise knowledge about SELF and about GOD, the Supreme Soul. I became Godloving instead of God-fearing. God now became my Supreme Father, Supreme Teacher and Supreme sadgati-daata. friend of mine once remarked: "I find soand-so, in spite of his so many qualities, a rather negative person."

Nothing new... this remark and a few incidents which I have come across many times have always made me ponder over the fact, as to why so many of us behave like this. It's a known fact that all people, more or less, can be divided into negatives or positives i.e. people having negative or positive attitude towards life.

Recently, I came across an article by Maulana Wahiduddin Khan in 'The Times of India'; he writes – positive thinking makes one a 'big bird thinker' and another term he uses is 'big bird thinking' which means human character with spirituality. We all have heard and talked so much of 'spirituality', as if it is a new trend, as if a new wave, a new fashion...to change the lives of all suddenly and very often we hear people proudly say 'I am going the spiritual way'. However, it is easy said than done. It is good indeed, very good if one truly understands what spirituality actually means. Is it following rules and regulations to discipline or is it to bind you to such an extent that even those qualities of the soul, a part of the divine soul, are put on a hold because of the fear of the world, if so, friends, this is nothing but... an outcome of a thought which is cultivated in a wrong way. We are made to think in certain ways because our society does not admit to it, because we are told this or that is right or wrong. But who makes or decides what is right or wrong? The thinker.

I come back to what Maulana Khan means when he talks about 'big birds'; he meant ...Big birds of the storm..., people with high thinking, people mature enough to give wellconsidered responses even in adverse conditions, rather than judging others and criticising them. Spirituality....is nothing but simple positive thinking.... Anyone who can keep a friendly behaviour towards every human being is positive and hence spiritual. I reiterate the fact that we ourselves are responsible for everything going around us even if it is making this world a difficult place to live in. Yes, negativity in the world is increasing, values are deteriorating and it is disintegrating the society. The thinkers.....you and I are accountable and no one else. If we want a new kind of society, people with pure thoughts, good moral values, there should be freedom to discover the new form. Anything that suppresses, diminishes or lessens cannot be freedom, neither to be free from attachments is freedom. Our actions based on past experiences are limiting, for they are not our own and therefore an obstacle. Our life is a series of actions at different levels of consciousness, but when these actions are unrelated, disjointed, they lead to frustration. There is no end in view and no result as such. what we want to be or what we want to do. They are all based on ideas emanating from our past experiences, beliefs or ideologies. Pre-conceived thoughts can never help in progress in the true sense. 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# READYMADE WORLD DRAMA

lthough Science has advanced vastly, it cannot answer why; instead answers how, on the basis of plus and minus. This plus and minus come as the roots of all mathematical explanations. For example, why did Newton's famous apple come down, not go up? Science answered that gravity of the earth pulled towards its centre, i.e. made the plus. So, the apple came down and could not go up. Here Science answered the mechanism of falling, hence it answered how, not why?

If an object is pushed by another object, it moves forward and science explains the phenomenon in this way: applied external force causes the movement of objects, i.e. makes a minus between.
