NEW ETHICS FOR THE NEW WORLD

he ethical teachings of all great religions of the world forbid certain acts. They consider those acts as sins and call upon their followers to abstain from those evil acts. For example, they condemn (1) lying, (2) injuring, (3) murdering, (4) slandering and (5) being subjected to drunkenness. Almost everyone understands what these religious injunctions mean. A devout Hindu, Muslim, Sikh, Christian, Buddhist, Jain or Jew tries to abstain from at least some of these acts fully or to the extent possible for him or her. And yet no one can refute the fact that there are millions of people, belonging to these religions, who commit these, without exerting much control over themselves. In this era, called 'Kaliyuga' or the 'Iron Age', there is hardly anyone who does not hurt anyone's feelings or injure the sensitivities of his neighbours, colleagues, family members or others with whom he interacts. There are many people who do not commit any murder, in the sense in which the word is commonly used and understood but there would be hardly a few who could say that they never tell a lie or speak the untruth or indulge in falsehood of any kind whatsoever. Similarly, the number of such people, who never indulge in an act of slander, would indeed be very-very small.

Whereas people already feel it very difficult to abstain from these vices in their usual sense, Shiv Baba has given a new connotation to these words, through the medium of Brahma Baba, and has, thus, added a new interpretation and a new meaning to these. But, He has also given additional strength and guidance that help to avoid these sinful tendencies, traits or acts. The new meaning that Baba has invested in these words, has widened their interpretation and has given a new awareness to those who aspire to raise their ethical standards.

For example, Baba has said that even those who do not commit any murder in the commonly prevalent sense of the word, may still be 'murderers' in another sense. If they do

WELCOME SESSION

Dadi Jankiji commended everyone for being loved dearly and held in regard by God Himself. It is time to reveal the true form of the Supreme Soul. One needs to pay equal attention to 'self', 'service' and 'relationships' to achieve this. Let any distances in relationships be bridged. Let us continue to give respect to one and all.

SERVICE IN FOREIGN COUNTRIES

- ▶ Indians living abroad, in particular, are taking much benefit from the BK Programmes aired on spiritual Television Channels.

The campaign can include lectures or activities around the theme of 'peace'.

He has been awarded the 'Ideal & Clean Village Award' by the President of India. REMEMBERING A GREAT SPIRITUALIST

orn in the sacred city of Multan, famous for its Sufis and saints, on 10th September 1929, Bro. Jagdish Chander Hassija was a bachelor, a surrendered Brahma Kumar; totally dedicated to Godly services and he mostly resided in Delhi. Before dedicating his life for spiritual services, he had served as Principal in a Technical Training Institute in Sonipat, for a brief period. Greatly inspired by Prajapita Brahma, founder of Brahma **Kumaris** organisation, he turned to spirituality and dedicated his life for this divine cause. He was a great litterateur and had the distinction of writing most of the literature of the Brahma Kumaris organization. He was also its Chief Spokesperson and Chief Editor of The World Renewal, Gyanamrit and Purity.

I would often take inspiration from him as I had opportunity to work with him, for Godly services, on many occasions. A simple and straightforward person, he took keen interest in divine service and worked very hard. He was a great visionary and contributed a lot for taking the organization to its present status and international recognition.

He was an affable person and took ample interest in developing the talents of B.K. brothers and sisters. Once, I had gone to meet him after having passed M.A. in Public Administration, in the year 1985. He enquired about the subjects we had studied during the course. In a humorous manner, he commented that we must have read about the experiments carried out on mice in connection with the theory of motivation under Management.

Brother Jagdish was particular that we should maintain quality in our publications. Once he had to present a paper at the IV International Symposium on Science and Consciousness at Uxmal, Yucatan, Mexico, from 4th to 8th January 1994. On that occasion, the paper "Nature of Consciousness in the Light of Raja Yoga, Gita and Some Other Disciplines" was presented by him. He deputed



me for editing and proof-reading of it and the work was carried out to his utmost satisfaction.

When I joined Diploma in English-Hindi, Hindi-English translation conducted by Delhi University, he was greatly pleased to know about it and commented that it would be of great use in Baba's service. During the course, we had to translate one book from English into Hindi, for which Bro. Jagdish suggested me to select a spiritual book. I selected Rajyoga: New Beginnings by B.K. Ken O'Donnel, published by the Brahma Kumaris organisation. By Baba's grace, I topped Delhi University in the examination and then met Bro. Jagdish for his guidance. He showed deep interest and enquired in detail about the process of translation.

Those days he was engrossed in replying to one legal notice regarding spiritual tenets and beliefs of the B.K. organisation. He asked me to translate his reply in Hindi. It was his intention to circulate that reply to each B.K. centre,

so that B.K. sisters could use that for explaining the spiritual concepts and Rajyoga tenets to aspirants, newcomers and the general public. The eighteenpage document translated by me in Hindi was then sent to each B.K. centre. It is rightly said that courageous persons turn even obstacles into stepping-stones to success.

Prajapita Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwa Vidyalaya successfully completed an international peace project. The book 'Visions for a Better World' was published on the successful completion of the project. Rajyogini Dadi Prakashmani was keen to get the book translated in Hindi. She asked Bro. Jagdish as to who could translate the book in Hindi. Bro. Jagdish recommended my name for this purpose. When I visited Mount Abu, Dadiji called me, discussed the matter with me and enquired how much time its translation would take and how to go about it, etc. I told her that that would take about two months time, being a voluminous book. She somehow postponed the project for the time being, considering several other factors, as quality and cost of multi-colour printing etc. in India.

Once I visited Mount Abu.

accompanied by B.K. Bro. Ram Nath of Vikas Puri, New Delhi. We arranged reservation in Delhi-Ahmedabad Rajdhani Express, which had just been introduced. Those days I was a senior executive in National Insurance Company Limited, and used to visit Mount Abu every month for editing The World Renewal. Those days, all the trains on that route used to originate from Old Delhi Railway Station. Therefore, presumed that Rajdhani Express would also originate from the same station. On reaching Old Delhi railway station half-an hour before the scheduled departure, we made enquiries and came to know that the train originates from New Delhi railway station. This perplexed us a lot. Though it was impossible to reach New Delhi station on time by any means, still we thought of taking a chance. Bro. Ram Nath stressed that if our services were required by Baba, the train would not leave before we reach.

We hired an auto-rickshaw and asked the driver to hurry. The driver made several manoeuvres through the congested roads and within twenty minutes took us to New Delhi Railway station. To make the matter worse, the train in those days used to depart from

platform number nine situated at the farthest end. Passing through the over bridge, somehow we reached the platform and to our great surprise, we found that the train was still at the platform. This was despite the fact that those days Rajdhani Express never used to be delayed.

On reaching our coach, we found Rajyogi B.K. Jagdish Chander standing at the entrance of our coach. He said smilingly, "I have been standing here like resolute and unshakeable Angad, not allowing the train to depart until my brothers reach". In fact he had read our names on the reservation chart and was waiting for us. Unable to hold my curiosity as to how the train had been late, I immediately went to enquire from the train driver. He said, "There is no particular reason for delay; we are just going to start". And within five minutes the train steamed off.

This was rather an extraordinary event in our life and it will remain etched forever in our memory. It proves strong determination and self-confidence of BK Jagdish Ji, which was possible due to divine intellect and positive thoughts through the constant practice of Rajyoga meditation.

This incident reminded me of an anecdote associated with Swami Dayanand Saraswati, the founder of Arya Samaj. It is believed that Swami Ji had stopped a king's chariot, pulled by powerful horses, just by the touch of his hand. The reason was that the king was going for some ignoble cause. Swami Ji first chided and then tried to dissuade him but the king didn't listen; Swami Ji held the rear portion of the chariot. It is believed that the horses didn't budge and the chariot couldn't move an inch.

Such incidents in fact are the victory of the positive and meditative mind. Those who lead a pious and serene life, attain certain inner powers, which are manifested even in mundane matters.

Mr Robin Ramsay, eminent Australian actor who participated with Bro. Jagdish in international spiritual service programmes vividly remembers his contribution, particularly his remarkable service during the Centenary of the World Parliament of Religions, held in Chicago, U.S.A., in 1993. Mr Ramsay was impressed by intellectual acumen, dignity and sense of humour of Bro. Jagdish. Mr Ramsay further noted that though Bro. Jagdish held high position; he had great humility

and worked at the grass-roots level with everybody. He was particular that things should be carried out in an appropriate and specific manner. He was a creative person and was always enthusiastic about new approaches to Godly Service.

In the year 2000, once we went to meet him at Derawal Nagar Centre, where he was recuperating in those days. He advised us that whatever endeavour we make, but our life should appear a yogi life. Bro. Jagdish Chander remained unwell for some time and left his mortal coil on 12th May 2001 Brahma Kumaris headquarters in Mount Abu. I was in those days in Mount Abu and a few minutes before he left his mortal coil, we had gone

to meet him at Sukhdham where he was staying. Thousands of BKs from all over the world gathered to pay their tributes to the departed soul. He had earnest desire to reveal to the world that God had descended on earth, in the human medium of Prajapita Brahma and was re-establishing heaven on earth, once again. Lakhs of Brahma Kumaris and Brahma Kumars have been putting special endeavours to spread this Godly message throughout the world.

Our heartiest salutations to this noble soul! As a tribute to him, we have been publishing his great thoughts under the column 'From the Mighty Pen of Sanjay' in The World Renewal.

LET'S PRACTISE WHAT BABA SAYS

Interview with Sister Mohini (New York)

(at Gyan Sarovar on 29.2.2012)

an you share about remembrance and the power of remembrance?

When we remember Incorporeal God Shiva, i.e. Shiv Baba, we have the aim of remembrance and to be totally merged in love with the One Supreme Being. So I sit with the thought, "let me remain merged with Baba." The power of remembrance develops to the same extent with which we remember Him. We remember something in order not to forget.... yet we also need to remember it at the right time. A good personality is one who knows what to remember, who has good quality memory, and as much as we remain in Baba's remembrance in a natural way we can forget what needs to be forgotten and remember what is real and true. Then the experience of being merged in love with Baba happens. As much as we remain and develop the power of remembrance then at the right time whatever is needed to be aware of will come into the mind.

Didi Manmohini used to

inspire us to write down what we had to do on a particular day. When I came to Baba, I was studying at university and also running the centre and I asked Mamma how I could manage this. She said it is important to write a 'to do' list, not as a burden, but as a plan. When the intellect stays plain, then the knowledge of Eternal World Drama keeps moving smoothly. What is a plain intellect?

We need to have very pure remembrance of God. When we have to do something, we have to remember it, and everything unnecessary is forgotten. Our external responsibilities need to be managed so that there is no stress or anxiety and we are not seen to be 'running' around. For this, we should keep our form and looks as a good yogi. Someone has called Sister Mohini 'a silent giant' and this is good, to keep the mind quiet, so as to have stamina and strength to do our work. If we think a lot, we will be exhausted before we start.

Baba many times says 'Make

Me your Companion'. When we have Baba as our companion, we have natural remembrance. He says 'Baba is your companion'. What is the practical experience of this companionship?

I have some fresh experiences of this and I remember in 1972, I was asked to go to London. I had to wait for my visa and I travelled to Germany first. Ever since Baba became Avyakt, I had been travelling in foreign countries. I realised that in saying' 'Haanji' (Yes), I could progress. So whatever the challenge or situation I went through, I thought I had a lot of courage since the beginning, that even if I go to the jungle, I will manage it. I had this faith. I said, "Baba, you are my companion; are you not?" And when I said this, I felt that my shoulders became light and He was carrying one bag and I was carrying the other. In Germany, I stayed for two months and I completed a tour of seven European countries in a van with two young brothers, Stephan and his friend. They were 24 and I was 30. They sat in the front and I sat in the back. Wherever we got invitations, we would go and stay with different families. Practically, I felt that Baba was with me. Whenever I could, I would sit in the same yoga posture as Brahma Baba and take rays from Shiv Baba and had many good experiences of the combined form. I would take sakash from Baba throughout the day and really develop the combined form of Shiva and Shakti. We could see how Brahma Baba and Shiv Baba combined themselves and so I could combine myself with Shiv Baba and do the same thing. It is important to create a living room in the heart for Baba. The attitude needs to be so clean that the inner living room can welcome such a guest. Baba must like everything inside Internally, I have to create such a nice living space for God so we can sit together here and chat.

I always feel that we need to keep the purity and cleanliness deeply within and actually create space for Baba so that His presence can be invoked. I have paid a lot of attention to the combined form. At this time whatever responsibilities we have, we need to keep this stage so that we are *yogyukt* and are able to do the Godly work.

I have understood to accept challenging situations to serve; yet we need strong experiences

of Baba's companionship. If life is easy going then we must keep the Almighty Authority with us; if we get a bit casual, the Almighty Authority will see this and go away. We need to do things using God's power, not our own power. Very few people do this. This is the proof of being an obedient and loyal child. I have the experience of having a supply, but there is also the supply up above which compliments fully. Baba is my Companion and so whenever I need, I just knock the door and He is there.

We can look at it another way. It is Baba's work and whenever something necessary He needs me. Why do I think that I need Him? We say 'Baba' helps and yet we are helping Him. Baba would always say 'Child, do this, do this'. So whose work is it? We say Baba helps. No. We say Baba I am ready and available for you. YOU ARE DOING AND I AMHELPING YOU. This is the Companionship. We should never say 'I give Baba so much'. Yet everything is Baba's. So we should say 'What can I take'. One needs to go into the depth of these things. Our time belongs to Baba and our body belongs to

Baba. Baba wants this type of 'inheritor'. Can I use this? Whose work is this? He made me His child and instrument and I just say 'yes'. He will give. If everything belongs to Baba then we have to ask permission. This is a sign of an inheritor who is fully surrendered.

In the last season and this season, Baba has talked about the need to emerge the heir souls. Baba's desire for this has not been fulfilled as He is still asking for them. Baba has told us the definition of heir soul. Why is this so; is there something lacking in us? Wherever I do service, I always have the aim that the heir souls will be running the Yagya. The Yagya is not run on the basis of donations. You have to see the quality of the soul. At every step, you will see that one in unlimited service makes their efforts profitable and successful by using everything for the yagya. It is not possible that everyone knows how to become a heir. Training is needed to become a heir. If you do not have a sense of being a heir soul how can you make anyone else one. How is a heir? Wherever I go, I see – who are the candidates. What is the meaning of being an inheritor? The quality of the

study of an heir is really like the *chatrak* bird; it will absorb so quickly and want to understand it all. You will see the way the person studies is a sign of being a heir.

Sometimes the instruments are in the limited and don't move into the unlimited and see how that person can be encouraged to go into the unlimited also. The inheritor is in the unlimited. They keep in their intellect that they really want to get their inheritance in the Confluence Age. The inheritors are those who take help from Baba, and they become the ones seated on Baba's throne. Any work they do, they do it with an attitude of being an instrument and attain success; they understand that they are an inheritor.

We feel that Baba is giving us a big package of opportunity and if we refuse, we are crossing out our fortune. I developed firm determination to do whatever I am asked to do trusting that Baba will give the power to be able to do it.

We have to recognise the inheritors and guide them. How does the inheritor think? We have to move the person beyond the limitations and with a lot of love move them forward. Dadi Janki does this service of showing souls how to move forward. I tell the sisters that there are so many inheritors and we should be inspiring them.

As much as we go into the unlimited, we can take others too. Body, mind and wealth should be for the whole *Yagya* and wherever it is needed. Bro. Brijmohan practised it in his life. Baba said and he did. We have to follow the lesson of 'Haanji' or "Yes, Baba".

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INTROSPECTION – KEY TO SELF-TRANSFORMATION



Il spiritual efforts are aimed selftransformation. It is popularly said that selftransformation leads to worldtransformation. Normally, people go to spiritual congregations for gaining spiritual knowledge and also for attaining peace through prayer, fasting, chanting sacred syllables, peregrination and other spiritual practices. Selftransformation does not happen simply because one goes to a spiritual assembly or participates in a prayer or meditation programme. It happens only when the participant is serious about what he has been doing and puts in efforts to transform himself with the power of knowledge he gets and the prayer he attends.

We all know that we have two levels of existence. One is physical and the other is spiritual. Even the basis of physical existence is the spiritual existence. People normally focus on the growth and development at the physical level through innovations, inventions and other techniques, which can enhance the physical comforts - B.K. Surendran, Bangalore

and facilities in the world. The physical lifestyle is modernised and updated day by day. Lots of changes keep happening at the physical level, whereas, such a transformation is not happening at the mental, behavioural and spiritual level. There is a mismatch between the outer development and the inner development. Therefore, in spite of high tech facilities, people are not happy with life. There is no peace of mind, happiness, security and solace in the midst of modern facilities and comforts.

Introspection by spiritual seekers

God reveals His personality during the confluence age. His sermons are listened to and His directions are accepted and followed by innumerable spiritual effort makers. The purpose of God's descent is understood and the effort makers also know the consequences. The speed with which our efforts should progress in the context of the global destruction and the emergence of the new world order is not given serious thought by many of us.

times, it is received lightly and acted upon as such. Even though the Lord is highlighting the points for effort making and the lag is also pointed out, many of us do not receive it with the seriousness it deserves. Sometime, we also feel that the Teacher is far ahead of us in imparting His lessons. If we say that we are about many years lagging behind to catch up with the teachings, it may not be That much of wrong. concerted efforts is necessary to catch up with the lessons and its experiences.

Perhaps, it appears that many of us and our efforts have come to a point of stagnancy and we have become somewhat complacent. We think that everything is ok. We are attending the discourse classes every day, and are regular in our amritvela meditation programme at 4 am and so on. In the field of service also, we are engaged in one-way or the other in Godly service only. But, the effort put in by Prajapita Brahma was much ahead of us. We seldom compare our efforts with Prajapita Brahma and ensure that our efforts are stepped up to the level of Prajapita Brahma. Prajapita Brahma has ascended to the subtle region successfully with his constant and fast effort making and also visiting us now alongwith the Lord during the season. Our aim is to be like Prajapita Brahma. If we do not scale up to that level, our life-long effort is at naught and we would be overtaken by death. We are here to conquer death and to attain angelic stage.

Developing strategies for serious introspection and follow up efforts

At the outset we can advance the amritvela by one minute every day until we reach 2 am every day. Prajapita Brahma used to meditate from 2 a.m. even though he was the chariot of the Lord. He was in fact the eldest of all effort makers, as he was in his 80s and 90s. We are all younger to him. We can identify the subtle areas of impurity in our thoughts, words and deeds and also relationship and design uncompromising strategies to remove these impurities so that the remembrance of the Lord is constant in our mind. We should be careful not to give sorrow to others. The thoughts of hatred, jealousy, arrogance, ego, revenge etc., are to be routed out completely. Let us take up the study of the sermons of the Lord with all seriousness like a diligent university student. Every evening from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. should be devoted to

intense meditation sessions, prominently focusing on service through mind. We should review the experiences gained through these meditation sessions and see that we progress every day. Our happiness level should go up, the sense organs should cool down, and outside situations should not affect us either positively or negatively. Our thoughts, words and deeds should match at all times. We should see that we are always truthful and thoughtful in thoughts, words, deeds and relationships.

There are certain demoniac sanskars deeply ingrained in the soul. We may be making lots of efforts to get rid of these sanskars. These should be identified and burnt out with the power of yoga. If we are not able to get rid of these sanskars on our own, we can also surrender to the Lord for help. With the blessings and help of the Lord we should see that such diehard habits and sanskars are burnt out with the intense remembrance of the Lord. We must create time for practicing soul consciousness and bodiless stage. We should set ourselves in a gymnastic mode to be in soul conscious stage, bodiless stage, in seed stage in incorporeal world, in angelic stage in subtle world, in

deity stage in golden age, as a Brahmin soul in confluence age, and as a worship worthy idol image in the copper and iron ages and so on.

We should watch out our stage. Our stage should move up through Iron Age to copper age, on to silver age and to golden age. We should step up our efforts to stay at the 1st step of golden age until we leave this body with our own volition. Our stage should be virtuous. We should bury the vices. There should be no trace of the vices. We should have no worldly desires. Our mind should be stable at all times and under all circumstances. In order to make these achievements, we must do a lot of self-convincing acts because if the self is not convinced we will not be able to successfully make the efforts. We must speak to ourselves and also give lot of self-suggestions. We must create interest for selfimprovement efforts in ourselves. We must convince ourselves regarding the necessity of making these efforts at this point of time. Since the Lord is with us, it is now possible to easily attain these stages. Because the Lord is with us and He is helping us to do these efforts, it is the appropriate time for us to scale

great heights, which will sustain our life for 84 births. We have to simply take one initial step and the remaining steps are guaranteed. When we look at the returns, the efforts look negligible.

Review of Yogi life

Some spiritual seekers say that after they have acquired Godly knowledge and learnt Rajyoga, they have noticed appreciable positive changes in their life. But the rate of progress has somehow slackened after they travelled some distance. Our introspection exercise will reveal that such and such areas of our yogi life should be reorganised more systematically with determination for quick results and also constant progress. Even though these areas are very familiar to us, yet a reminder will help us in a big way.

Attention on our thoughts

We should not generate negative, waste and vicious thoughts. These thoughts are a hindrance to our progress. This is possible only when we focus on positive, pure and Godly thoughts. Purposeful and systematic study of the sermons of the Lord will help us in generating powerful, positive

and pure thoughts.

Go to bed at 10 p.m. punctually with the right state of mind

We have to organise the day's activities in such a way that every day we must retire to bed at 10 pm punctually with the right state of mind. We should spend at least 10 minutes in the remembrance of the Lord and then retire to bed. This will help us wake up at *amritvela* at the desired time with the loving thoughts of the Lord.

Pay attention to food, words, conduct and behaviour during the day

Our food, words, conduct and behaviour affect our daily spiritual life. This will have adverse impact on our spiritual life, which can retard our progress in case it is not according to the directions of the Lord. Hence, satvic diet, soft and sweet words and courteous, polite and civil conduct and behaviour will always help us on the path of spirituality during the day.

Commence the day with a powerful thought

A powerful thought is the remembrance of the Lord. As soon as we wake up, let us remember the Lord and look at Him with the highest regard and veneration. Then, let us think of a powerful thought like 'This

day I am going to be happy under all circumstances'.

Practice brief spells of meditation during the day

Even though we have specifically fixed 7 times 3 minutes each meditation sessions in the form of thought traffic control exercises, many of us seldom practice them. We must become aware of the timings and devote time to practice it. Similarly, again for each hour of the day, oneminute meditation session should also be practiced. If we seriously consider these meditation sessions, this will help us in streamlining our daily routine smoothly to ensure constant meditation mindset and for creating a soul conscious daily life.

Renounce desire for name and fame, honour and glory, reward and award

Even though many of us speak of renunciation and disinterest in real life, in some of us there is the urge and thought for recognition, name, fame, honour, glory, reward and award. These desires create hurdles in the spiritual path. But we forget the fact that we are instruments of God and all of our knowledge and other special qualities are all blessed by the

Lord. We should dedicate all our efforts and services to God without longing for their returns. This will keep us on the path of spirituality and we can easily move forward.

Obstacles, fatigue, loss of ease and comfort

As we keep on progressing in spiritual life, there would be more and more obstacles coming up on the way. Sometimes, we become tired and feel the pinch of fatigue. We start losing our ease and comfort. We must understand that obstacles should come then only we will learn new lessons in the path of spirituality. These come to us to educate us on new areas. We gain experiences of sorts in the process. Therefore, we should welcome problems and thank the trouble creators. By looking at the blocks, we should not get tired and lose our ease and comfort. Those who are living in the company of the Lord will never feel the pinch of obstacles. They will never become tired.

Involve us in Godly service

Godly service is an opportunity blessed by the Lord for us to contribute to world welfare. Godly service is an act of charity. The act of giving happiness to others is Godly service. On one hand we grow spiritually and on the other hand we make others happy. This kind of service will help us and make us grow spiritually. Wherever we are, we should make it a point to see that we involve ourselves in some kind of Godly service.

The bus had just passed 'Jorabat'. It was about 11 p.m. then. The bus was moving slowly on the serpentine ghat road. After a while, a Jeep from the opposite direction suddenly appeared in front of the bus. The bus driver somehow managed to stop the bus; but in the process the bus collided gently with the Jeep.

Suddenly about ten young guys wearing black pent-shirts came out of the open jeep. All of them were carrying wooden sticks with them. It was understood that the passengers would be looted. Everyone's heart beat increased. The bus driver was clever and experienced. He left his seat at once and occupied a vacant seat, pretending to be a passenger.

One of the young guys entered the bus and finding the driver seat empty, got very annoyed. "Where is the driver? Where has he gone?"- The guy asked the passengers with a gigantic voice.

When no one replied, he asked one of passengers about the driver. When he said that the bus driver had gone away, the young guy got very angry and showered blows on him. He then shouted angrily – "The driver could not have left the bus. He must be here in the bus amongst the other passengers. If the passengers do not reveal the driver, then we will destroy the whole bus." Already the other young guys started to hit the bus with their sticks; the sound of broken glass created panic.

B.K. Jonali spoke in the same tone, "Brother, will you be pleased if your mother, sister or any brother are looted while they are travelling?" Before she could conclude, the young boy told gently –"We are not talking about you. We will not take money from you."

B.K. Jonali continued, "But the other people are also our brothers. I have sympathy for them also."

After a while, she again

started to speak – "I think the bus driver may not have so much money with him. But still you can easily solve this simple problem by getting your money from the proprietor of the bus agency".

The young guy – "Madam, how can we meet the proprietor now? How can we collect money from him?"

WISDOM: THE FIFTH WEAPON

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the term 'New Age Spirituality'. It seems neither unfamiliar nor familiar to many of us. Why familiar? Because many of us like to believe that in some way we are already spiritual and we very well know what spirituality means! Why unfamiliar? Because, we may wonder, at times, about what it has got to do with the 'New Age'.

In that case we may try to understand the terms like 'New Age', 'Spirituality' and 'Religion' more elaborately. You may ask me, why do we need to spend time on understanding these terms once again because we have all been using these terms very often and we know them very well. Right? You are absolutely right there! But then

I would ask you, are spirituality and religion two different phenomena? Perhaps, you may say that 'yes, they, are two different phenomena. Some of you may also wonder, thinking that is there really any difference; essentially both are two sides of the same coin. Well, either way can be said to be right. Or there may be a third answer too. In short, each of us has our own perception as to the nature of spirituality and religion. It is interesting to observe that more and more people now prefer to describe themselves as spiritual and not religious.

The question is, when we say so, have we really defined the distinction between being religious and not being religious, but spiritual. Many of us simply mean to say that I do not nurture any extreme affinity toward any of the known religions, but I feel I have reached a higher stage of human consciousness and from that point of view, I am spiritual. However, in our private lives we have not given up the religion we have inherited. We still follow the ways of our ancestors as far as the rituals are concerned. There is nothing wrong in that. What I am trying to point out is that there are no clearly drawn boundary lines between being religious and spiritual. Or if at all there are such distinctions, are between the performance of rituals according to a certain given way and non-performance of rituals.

Religion and rituals are two different things. Rituals are the markers of the regimentation of our lifestyle as members of a given group of people who profess to belong to a certain religion, while religion itself is a philosophy that gives you the basic 'do's' and 'don'ts for living a meaningful and gratifying life. However, in course of time, most of the human communities tend to forget this and equate their religion with rituals.

The moment we begin to gain some awareness about the distinction between the regimentation brought by rituals and the deep-seated philosophy of a religion, we may claim that we have stepped into the realm of the higher wisdom inherited by entire humanity. To me that is the beginning of our spiritual journey. Once the journey begins it's a long way, though!

I would, at this point, like to bring you to the traditional understanding of spirituality. There are two levels of spirituality in the Indian tradition termed Abhyudaya as (achievement) and NiHshreyas (attainment). NiHshreyas or Moksha is the state beyond even bliss, beyond awareness of the Manifest, i.e. oneness with the Brahman, which is the ultimate goal of spirituality. Common people understand it as freedom from the cycle of rebirths. It was a common misconception of westerners that Indian tradition was so concerned with NiHshrevas that it neglected everything about the day-to-day life and a person's well being therein.

However, this was never the case. Ancient Indians understood human life as an intricately woven thread of the entire canvas of the manifest world. If this thread gets weaker, the entire canvas would be tattered. Hence, humanity carried a greater responsibility

of maintaining it in its prime grandeur. To do so means to let the cosmic cycle run without any hindrance. Whatever actions by humans led to hamper the smooth running of the cosmic cycle was considered unrighteous. To conduct oneself toward the fulfilment of one's inborn duty, in order to maintain the cosmic cycle was *Dharma*.

Human beings were advised to follow the path of righteousness and achieve Abhyudaya or achievement by honest means. Fulfilling of all the family and social duties in a graceful way was the underlying meaning of Abhyudaya and not mere material prosperity; similarly only the one who had fulfilled all these duties was entitled to seek NiHshreyas. Rather, he was already set to reach this goal. This was the sum total of spirituality as viewed in the ancient tradition. The path of Dharma was the path of spirituality. With the genesis of human greed, we were given to forget that spirituality has always been inherent in us. With the increasing materialism, we began to believe that it is an external factor and we must find it by special efforts. New Age spirituality is offering us the means to find and reinstate it by

easier means, which would be agreeable to the modern intellectual humans. It is urging us to go back to our roots, know ourselves and realize that we are spiritual by default, to find that lost wisdom. That lost wisdom is the real weapon to overcome the spiritual-mundane dichotomy forever.

I would like to narrate a story to conclude my sharing with you. There was a king whose name was Brahmadatta. When Bodhisattva was born as his son, the sages predicted that he would grow to be a very powerful prince endowed with five celestial weapons. Hence, he was named Panchâyudha. As a youth of sixteen, he was sent to Taxila for higher education. After completing the education successfully at Taxila, he returned home. On his return journey. he was stopped by an ogre. He refused to submit to the ogre. When challenged, he fought with the ogre. First he used his arrow and bows, then his sword, then the wheel, and then the club. All got stuck into the ogre's body and yet she was standing there, unflinching. When the ogre approached him, he threatened her that if she ate him up, she will suffer very badly because his fifth weapon was still with him, intact. That weapon was not external, but was a part of him. It was 'wisdom'. The ogre did not believe fully in the prince, but still scared, she let him go. This fifth weapon to fight the ogre of ignorance has always been within us. Spirituality is to know that and continue to empower ourselves with the awakened wisdom.

MANSA SEVA , CONSCIOUSNESS AND SCIENCE

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here are about 200 types of Meditation taught and practised throughout the world. Only a few of them are evidence-based. One of them is Brahma Kumaris Rajayoga, which in my experience, is superduper prescription for everlasting health, happiness, harmony and peace in life. Dr. Garret, once again instructed," Look over her shoulder and see what she is writing."The hypnotized soldier delightfully said "She is writing that she is sorry for her part in the quarrel". Later, the following day, the young man received a letter by special delivery from his sweetheart, the very letter which the soldier had read astrally.

A study published in "The journal of offenders' Rehabilitation" reports that a group of people met regularly

and meditated with the thoughts of "Love and Peace" for the whole world over a period of two years. This simple act reduced all acts of "Terrorism" by a phenomenonal 72 per cent. Another study published in 1999, showed that the violent crimes in Washington DC decreased by 23.6 per cent in just two months period. As soon as the meetings of the meditators stopped, the crime levels started going up again. Fifty different scientific studies over preceding 30 years have shown that the meditators created miraculous improvement in health and Quality Of Life (Q.O.L.) world-wide. Along with the impact on the health and emotions, there was a decrease in crimes, accidents. wars, violence and riots. Dr. Hew Len's Hawaiian Ho'oponopono:- Dr. Len, a Hawaiian psychiatrist, was made incharge of a ward where they kept criminally insane and dangerous patients. Psychiatrists quit on a monthly basis. Dr. Len did an innovative act in addition to the usual therapy - his version of Hawaiian Ho'oponopono. In his chamber he held each patient's file and kept on saying "I am sorry" and "I love you" over and over again. Within few months of this. Dr. Len's version of Ho'oponopono, the patients who had to be shackled were allowed to walk freely. Others who had to be heavily medicated, started getting off their medication. Those who had absolutely no chance of getting released, were freed. Absenteeism of the staff disappeared. Soon the staff outnumbered the patients and today the ward is closed. — (... Contd. from Page No. 3) not kill any man or woman by throttling them or by shedding their blood, they still might be throttling their conscience, their correct inner voice. It is a 'murder' of the Atman, so to say. It is a bloodless murder, which almost everyone has committed on many occasions in his lifetime and yet this kind of 'murder' is not mentioned in any Criminal Procedure Code in any country or even in the code of ethics of any religion. However, this is the kind of murder that precedes all other kinds of murders and conspiracies, for that would give him sanity and would advise self-control.

Moreover, there are millions of people who do not kill any human being but they kill animals or birds so as to eat, sell or serve others' flesh, i.e., meat. If they themselves do not use a knife or a gun to kill these innocent beings, they abet others in this sin of taking nonvegetation food. If the law of a land considers murder as a serious crime, will not God or Dharma consider killing these innocent living beings as a sin? If even the intent, the abetment or participation in hatching a conspiracy is a crime, will not meat eating be considered as

a participation in the sin of animal killing? If human beings have the right to live, have not other beings also a sacred right to live?

This last-mentioned sin, viz. meat eating, also is due mainly to one's inattentiveness and indifference to the voice of the conscience. If a person says that his conscience has permitted him to do this, then it means that his conscience is already dead by his repeated acts of throttling or stabbing it.

Further, one may not be a murderer or butcher but one may commit another kind of assault, which is also called 'criminal assault'. In fact, sexlust leads a person to make such an assault on another. One may not make this assault in act but may commit it in mind, or even in dreams, or through one's sexy looks on another. In that case, one's mind works like a sword or his eyes work as a sabre or a dagger.

Now consider the word 'lying'. If anyone calls another a liar, the latter does not take it kindly. He hits back, saying: 'I'm not a liar; you who are falsely accusing me of committing this sin, are lying.' When any person wishes to make a statement to the court,

he takes an oath, saying that he is not lying but is saying the truth, the whole truth and nothing but truth. Telling lies is considered such a great sin that people take the Gita or any other sacred book in their hand in order to testify that they are not telling a lie. Truth is such a great virtue that God, the Holiest Being, is given this attributive name - Truth or Satyam. Gandhi, regarded as Mahatma, even said that Truth is God and that he was doing experiments with Truth. Maharaja Harish Chandra, an Indian legendary king, is praised for his speaking the truth even in very difficult situations. Some people praise this virtue so much that they say that if you speak the truth invariably and under all circumstances, then you will not commit other sins also, for such is its purifying influence on the soul. Now all that has been said about Truth is not new; much of it is known to people already. But, Baba drew our attention to another aspect of it. He said that the basic or the fundamental truth is that each and every one of us is a soul, and not body. But how often does one identify himself with this, regarding these particulars as referring to his own 'self'! For example, when someone questions another: 'Sir, who are you' or 'What are you?'; the latter answers: 'I am a young man; I'm a doctor; I am an Indian, I am twenty five years old, ...:". Now all these particulars relate to one's body so, everyone is telling lie because everyone is ignorant of the true identity of the self. In fact, only a few are living the truth because many people are living a life of identification with their body.

Similarly, if we ask people where God is, they say: "He is everywhere; He is present here also and is watching us." But when you further ask them: "Gentleman, how do you know He is everywhere and watching you? And, further, if He is a Person and is our Father, as you say, how could He be omnipresent?', then they say: "We do not know. We believe in this because the scriptures say so or because the sages said so; we cannot see Him and He cannot be known wherefore, the scriptures say 'Neti, neti' about Him." Well, that means that they have been believing a hearsay only, without ascertaining or inquiring about it. They themselves say that God cannot be known, which means that they also do not know Him! So, how can anyone who does not know and who also believes that the truth about God (or God, the Truth) cannot be known, claim that He is speaking the truth? But, the wonder is that when we go to a religious congregation where a preacher is dilating on the theme that God Omnipresent, we find the audience responding by saying "Satya Vachan, Maharaj, i.e. you are very-very true, dear Mr. Preacher!"

So, if people are not telling the truth about their own real identity and if the religions are telling something to which they give the label of truth but which, in fact, is not true, can we not say that every one of us has been a liar life after life?

Now, let us think over 'slander'. There are, no doubt, many people who are decent in their conduct and behaviour. They observe self-reliance. They speak gently and try not to slander, but we see that millions of religious-minded people have been slandering deities – gods and goddesses in India. They have been uttering blasphemy about Brahma and Saraswati, about Shankar and Parvati and about Vishnu, Krishna, Rama etc.,

etc. There can be no worse kind of slander because this slander is by preachers or socalled sages or Rishis and it relates to those deities who had exemplary character. To say that Brahma, the Father of mankind had lascivious intent his towards daughter, Saraswati, and that he ran after her with lust in his mind, and to say also that Shri Krishna had 16, 108 consorts and had ten children from each one of them is the biggest ever slander. It could go in the Guinness Book or Limca Book of Records because no one has beaten this record of slander! Those who say that they do not commit murder and those who preach to others that murder or assassination is a sin themselves commit this heinous act of character -assassination and a grave act of slander.

Not only that, some sages of the yore have written worst slander of women. They have condemned the whole gender or class of women as 'poisonous she-snakes!,' 'shackles in the feet of men', 'doorways to hell' and so on. To condemn a whole class, constituting about fifty percent of human population as 'ghouls' or fiends or 'those who are worthy of being given a beating' is the worst kind of slander or calumny.

Now about 'Drunkenness'. It is not only alcohol that takes a person into an altered state of mind, known as drunkenness or intoxication. There are other drugs also which make a man lose his human sense and become almost mad or even a brute. But can we say that those who do not take anyone of such intoxicating drugs are never in a drunken state? No; not at all.

There are some Heads of States who are drunk with military power, there are many rich men who are deeply intoxicated with money and its power; there are political leaders in whose head political power sits tightly and rules. Not only that, there are some young people who are drunk with the intoxication of youth or muscle power; there are learned or socalled 'wise men', who are in a drunken state because of the hot pride of their learning or erudition.

The matter does not end with these bigwigs. In fact, every person is in a drunken state because of body-consciousness. If everyone, without a single exception, were not drunk, why would they be mad with sex-lust? Is the influence of sex-lust any amount less than the intoxication brought by alcohol? Does it not cloud a person's intellect as much as alcohol does? Does a person not lose his human sense and his sanity under the influence of anger? So, is greed which makes a person lose all sense of shame. All the vices alter a person's state of mind; they reduce him to the state of an animal or a drunkard person and they deprive him of his judgment, balance and selfrespect. So, Shiv Baba has given us this interpretation of the words and has asked us to be free from all these kinds of drunkenness and to have only the divine intoxication that each and everyone of us is a child of God, the Highest and the Holiest, and that we are would-be deities. This kind of intoxication, called *Narayani Nasha*, is harmless.

We need not dilate on 'injury', which is another sin. All human beings injure the feelings of others many times in their lives. They injure others in many ways.

Thus, these examples illustrate how Shiv Baba has given us New Ethics for the New World through His corporeal medium Prajapita Brahma.
