Report on

An Experiential SEMINAR on

"SOCIO-SPIRITUAL RESPONSIBILITY AND SUSTAINABLE GROWTH"

27 APRIL 2013, Om Shanti Retreat Centre (ORC), MANESAR, GURGAON

Spiritual Applications Research Centre (SpARC Wing), a spiritual service wing of Brahma Kumaris organized a seminar on "Socio-Spiritual Responsibility and Sustainable Growth" on 27th April, 2013 at Brahma Kumaris' Om Shanti Retreat Center (ORC), Manesar, Gurgaon.

The concept of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) is not new, but the prime objective of this seminar was to throw light on the socio-spiritual aspect of corporate social responsibility and how Brahma Kumaris have achieved incredible results in various areas with the aim of serving the society by implementing these very principles of socio-spiritual approach.

In the seminar, Brahma Kumaris showed new dimensions to address various issues by demonstrating the importance of CSR in relation to spirituality and how to achieve desired results by acting "Responsibly" and "Ethically".

The Seminar provided an excellent opportunity to the participants to explore:-
