Call to declare Mount Abu a global spiritual city

Abu Road, March 29: Union Minister of State for Social Justice and Empowerment Ramdas Bandu Athawale has assured government support for a suggestion to make Mount Abu in Rajasthan a world spiritual city.

Speaking during the valedictory session of the Brahma Kumaris' 80th anniversary celebrations, he applauded the organisation for its noble work in several fields, including women's empowerment and environment, and said no progress was possible without peace.
