

Dearest Nikunj,

Om Shanti and Greetings from all of us here in Nairobi!!!!!!!

It has been nearly 4 weeks now that we are in Africa. During this time we visited few parts of Kenya and Zimbabwe. You might be aware that we are making this new film "***the time is.... NOW***" which deals with the recognition of our Inner Power and application in times of crisis. The message from this film that one can get is that no matter how bad the situation of the present world is, but still there is hope.... How each one's life is affected by the present situation of the world and how we can recognize our Inner Power with the help of God's Power. So with this theme, we have been interviewing common people trapped in uncommon situations and how they have come out of these situations with the help of their Inner Power and their will to survive.

Out of these interviews we would like to share one example. In Nakuru, about an hour's drive from Nairobi, we interviewed people who are staying in the Internally Displaced People (IDP) Camp. These are the people who have survived the Post Election Violence. This event took place in early 2008 which has been the worst case of human violence in Kenya. The local tribes were killing each other because of the political leaders who were contesting the elections. These souls have faced traumatic situations in their life and still have got no help from any where. An excerpt from one of the interviews: "**we know our situation is not good and we have faced so much, that it is obvious for us to hate people from the tribes who have killed our families. There was a time when we felt that there is no ending to this.... but again we thought that hating each other will create more hatred and this is not going to solve the purpose. Instead, we should go beyond this and try to forgive each other. So now we are staying together in this camp with all the 8 tribes who were killing each other at the time. The Police and the Government didn't even bother to know whether we are alive or dead, but we knew that our prayers would be heard by someone in the world and they will reach us. We thank God that He sent you to hear us and bring our voice to the world.**" So these kind of experiences have been documented on the camera. We all were so touched by their experiences that our eyes became moist and we all thanked God for giving us a chance to give yogdan and vibrations of peace to all these souls who are crying for help. We felt we should share this first hand experience with you.

In addition to these survivor interviews, we interviewed some VIPs also. Now we have on board the followings VIPs:

- Hon. Mr. Moses Akaranga, former Minister of State for Public Services and Vice Chairman of the National Humanitarian Advisory Board which monitors the IDP Camps in Kenya
- Mrs. Florence Jaoko, Chairperson of Kenya National Commission on Human Rights
- Ms. L Muthoni Wanyeki, Executive Director of Kenya Human Rights Commission

Plus, we got a chance to attend a program with Pratibhaben in which we met the Former President of Kenya Hon. Daniel Arap Moi, Hon. George Saitoti who is the Minister for Internal Security & Hon. Moses Mudawadi who is the Minister for local Government. We got a good opportunity to give Baba's message to these VIPs too. Infact Hon.Moses Akaranga visited our Nairobi center and gave his Interview for the film too. One more thing, we experienced that the shooting of this film became instrumental in bringing some very important mic souls close to Baba.

We are extremely thankful to Vedantiben, Pratibhaben and all Centerwasis from Kenya & Zimbabwe for their love, care and wonderful support.

Last, but not the least..... thank you so much for all your good wishes and blessings for this project because of which this Africa filming schedule has been so successful. Now we are flying back to India tomorrow and we will reach back to Madhuban on the 17th May.
